#### Search and View Commemoration Details

You can search and view details on all official commemorations for Australians located in Australia or Papua New Guinea (PNG).

Details on war-dead veterans from World War 1 and 2 will also be available via a link to the Commonwealth War Graves Commission site.

#### To search and view official commemoration details online:

1. Complete any known search criteria.





You can search by either name, service number / type, year range or location.

#### 2. Click on the Submit button.

### **Download War Grave Photos**

Each commemoration may have two types of war grave photos available:

Image Type	Description	Example
Whole	Displays the commemoration in full.	
Detailed	Displays the headstone / plaque of the commemoration in enough detail that the information can be read / viewed.	t Carter

You can download a photo of a war grave online in two ways:

- search results list
- commemoration details screen.

#### To download a photo from the search results list:

1. From the Search for a commemoration screen, complete any known search criteria and click on the **Search** button.

2. Click on the Photo(s) link for the veteran.

3. Click on the **Download** link.

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#### **Request a Photo of a War Grave**

If the commemoration does not have any photos on file you can request a photo of the war grave. When making requests, fields marked with a red asterisk (\*) are mandatory.

4. Navigate to the photo and click on the **Open** button.



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- 5. From the **Title** drop down list, select your title.
- 6. In the First name field, enter your first name.
- 7. In the Family name field, enter your surname.
- 8. In the **Phone** field, enter your preferred contactable phone number.
- 9. In the Email field, enter your email address.

Ensure you have read and agree to the terms and conditions at the bottom of the window.

- 10. Tick the checkbox to agree with the terms and conditions.
- 11. Click on the **Submit** button.

#### **Request Amendments to Commemoration Details Displayed Online**

If you believe the commemoration details displayed on the Commemoration details screen are incorrect, you can request that these details are amended.

#### To request amendments to commemoration details displayed online:

1. From the Search for a commemoration screen, complete any known search criteria and click on the **Search** button.

3. From the **Title** drop down list, select your title.



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- 4. In the First name field, enter your first name.
- 5. In the Family name field, enter your surname.
- 6. From the **Relationship to veteran** drop down list, select your relationship to the veteran you are requesting the commemoration details be amended for, eg Grandparent.
- 7. In the **Phone** field, enter your preferred contactable phone number.
- 8. In the **Email** field, enter your email address.
- 9. From the **Request to amend** drop down list, select what details you would like to amend, eg Service details.
- 10. In the **Provide details about the information you believe is incorrect** field, enter specific detail around what information is incorrect.



You can upload supporting documentation, such as death certificate, that will assist DVA in verifying that the changes to the commemoration information you are requesting are correct.

11. Click on the **Submit** button.
